




El Alamein 1942, my grandfather survived to the battle and was made prisoner. What he dreamed: freedom, a world in peace, his girlfriend, to return in Italy?

(art. 4) and the full development of the human person (art. 3.2)

How to make dreams real?


The inspiration of the future needs permanent change of the present.

Ecomuseums and museums as "places of the muses" can inspire people to address the needs of change


Museums with insight from the past as well as with creativity of the muses, can help to forge a public vision for the 21st century.




#### 2. Involve Institutions

part of Milan








#### 4. Plan and act with citizens

The ecomuseum, which is a museum of the community, is legitimated by the participation of citizens. The ecomuseum of Argenta plans and works not only "for" but also "with" the community; this is in accordance with the logic of active citizenship and the subsidiarity principle.



#### 5. Map the heritage

In the Ecomuseum of Casentino, to realize the ecomuseum action plan, a parish map was drawn. The parish map is a participatory mapping of a landscape, resulting from a shared reading of the tangible and intangible heritage.

To update and implement the map contents, an interactive and multimedial map was realized.



# 6. Publish with copyleft licence

All media about products and processes of the Grigne ecomuseum are published under an open licence and are free for sharing and adapting.






Italian ecomuseums have produced a strategic manifesto aimed at contributing to the creation, development and evolution of ecomuseum experiences that can produce virtuous models of sustainable local development. The goal is a new museology that is increasingly committed to finding alternative strategies for local development.

These strategies are linked to the local communities' desire for change; to a practice that encourages the management and use of cultural, environmental and landscape heritage for the purpose of local and community development.




During the 2016 ICOM General conference a working group of ecomuseums and community museum was made. It is guide by a steering committee made up of representatives from all over the world. The guide role of the committee was assigned to the network of italian ecomuseums. Together, the steering committee reviewed and compiled ideas, issues and debates raised by participants during the Forum. From this compilation process, a common vision emerged which has resulted in a provisional "2016 Milan Cooperation Charter". The hope is that the Charter will be shared widely amongst ecomuseums communities and their partners, thereby becoming a rallying point for all those who share this vision of museums.

As the number of people who sign the Charter grows, The international network will help advance the agenda for community-engaged museums. The Steering Committee expects to produce a revised Cooperation Charter as soon as possible, building on the inputs from the expanding group of engaged professionals.



The steering committee published the DROPS international platform, a website FOR EXCHANGE AND EXPERIENCE SHARING.

The platform aims at connecting all national Ecomuseums and Community Museums and their networks, existing or to be established, and all other heritage and landscape NGOs, in a virtual and interactive space. The purpose of the platform is the production of a multilingual documentary and a bibliographic pool of resources on ecomuseology and its best practices. A platform section helps ecomuseums and community museums to call for partners of a project or for papers, to share through the DROPS platform projects, papers, books, suggestions and proposals.



I started with my grandfather and now I would like to end with the "grandfather of ecomuseums". Hugues de Varine used to be defined like this. In the picture Hugues de Varine is looking at the slide of a speech in the meeting of ecomuseums of Brazil that took place in Amazonia some years ago. At the time I was a guest of the meeting and I take this picture with this quote by Helder Camara a brazilian bishop: "...".
